

SAMSARA RIDGE AT WOLF CREEK

DIRECTIONS

2701 240th Ave /Co Rd G
Sterling Township, WI 54840

- Located 7 miles North of St. Croix Falls, WI (across the river from Taylor's Falls, MN)
- Driving time is about 1 ¼ hours from the Twin Cities
- This is a very scenic route, yet I have timed it to be just as fast as I-35 N to Hwy 8
- Please relax, take your time and enjoy the drive, remember- *the journey is the destination!*

From Minneapolis/Saint Paul:

- I-35 North to Hwy 36 East
- Continue on Hwy 36 E for 5 miles past 694 to Manning Rd/Hwy 15 North (look for sign marked “North of Stillwater”)
- Left (North) on Manning Road to Hwy 96 (about 5 miles)
- Turn right (East) on Hwy 96 until it dead ends at Hwy 95
- Turn left (North) on Hwy 95 until it ends at Hwy 8 roundabout (about 20 miles)
- Turn right (East) on Hwy 8, three miles to Taylor's Falls

From Taylor's Falls, MN:

- Continue straight (East) on Hwy 8 across bridge over St. Croix River into Wisconsin
- Take first left (North) after crossing the river on Hwy 87, go through town of St. Croix Falls
- Continue North on Hwy 87 for about 2 miles to River Road, only on the left
- Turn left (West) on River Road (*Pay attention- it is not marked ahead of the turn!*)
- *If you miss this turn you can continue North on 87 for about 5 miles, then go left on Co Rd G/240th Ave*
- Follow River Rd as it turns North, with the St Croix river on your left, until it dead ends at 230th Ave
- Turn Left (West) on 230th Ave, it will quickly turn right and become River Road again
- Follow River Rd for about 1 mile, past the Wolf Creek Bar on the left
- Take the immediate right (East) 1/8 mile after the bar, on to Co Rd G/240th Ave
- Continue on Co Rd G going uphill about ½ mile, over Wolf Creek to the first driveway on the left
- Our lower driveway is next to a sign with ‘*Vote for the Planet*’
- About ¼ uphill past that driveway is our upper driveway, along the top of the ridge, marked 2701
- If the entry gates look locked, they may not be- they just look that way. Unclip the wire on the right side.
- *Welcome!*
